



Fund Developer

This position will work with the Artistic Director of Still Moon Arts, the Moon Festival Director, members of the Still Moon Arts Board, and the summer team. It is designed to support the funding needs of the Society and the fundraising ideas of the Board, while catering to the goals and skills of the summer student. Through this job, the student will be able to build a deeper understanding of the daily administrative, budgeting, and artistic tasks required to run a small non-profit community arts organization.

Responsibilities

- Develop year-long strategy for fundraising beyond grants in collaboration with the Board of Directors and Communications Committee
- Create and deliver presentations and fundraising proposals to the Still Moon Arts Board
- Research and develop fee-for-service educational opportunities and other social enterprise ideas with Still Moon Arts, including updating website and gathering testimonials
- Collaborate with Youth Engagement Coordinator, Board of Directors, and summer team to develop and implement fundraising ideas
- Collaborate with Communications Coordinator to update sponsorship packages, effectively utilize social media, and create marketing strategy
- Cultivate new donors in local businesses and community organizations: build strong relationships on mutual assistance and recognition
- Work with Artistic Director in grant writing and reporting
